Student absences in Toddle

We are excited to share that we've now fully transitioned to using **Toddle**! To help us streamline communication, we kindly ask that you use Toddle to report your child's absences. This includes notifying us when your child is sick or has appointments, such as a visit to the dentist. Please remember to report the absence in Toddle for **each day** your child is away from school (e.g., day 2, 3, etc.).

For leave related to holidays or other planned absences, you must still use the **Application for Leave** form as before. Absences submitted through Toddle for this purpose, or by email cannot be approved. You can find the leave application form here:
